Visiting Engadi During Covid

We are excited you're coming back. We wanna update you on what you can expect as you come back to Guatemala.

Previous to the trip

- Before you come, be sure to get a COVID test. It can be a PCR test or a rapid Antigen test at any certified laboratory near you. It must be a Nasal Swab.
- Ensure to get your test within 72 hours of boarding your flight to Guatemala.
- Make sure your name appears on your COVID test as it does on your passport.
- Bring a **printed** copy of your COVID test to the airport.
- Highlight your name, the date you did the test, the type of test, and your negative result.
- As of January 10, 2022, the Guatemalan government also requires everyone flying into Guatemala to show their vaccine card with at least two shots. This may change at any time.

Arriving in Guatemala

- Present your Vaccine Card and your COVID test to the medical staff receiving the flight.
- In spite of what the airline may say, everyone needs to fill out their own personal immigration form. It is not one per family.
- Go through immigration and pick up your baggage, as usual.
- Wait in the "hotel and rental car lobby" until all your team members are through customs with all their bags.
- Make contact with the Engadi personnel before walking outside.

While in Guatemala

- Maintain social distancing by keeping 6 feet apart in all public areas. We know that is difficult when we are working on construction, but we have to comply with the government regulations as best we can.
- Always wear your mask in public places, otherwise you may be fined \$75 for not wearing it.
- On the bus we must ensure social distancing by staying at 75% of the vehicle's capacity.
- The use of hand sanitizer is recommended.
- Always wash your hands.

At the team house

- Wash your hands in the restrooms in the garage before entering the house.
- Maintain social distancing at the team house to the best of our ability.
- We are taking all the necessary precautions to prepare the food properly.

Extra things to bring:

- Extra face masks.
- Lots of hand sanitizer.

Before your leave

• You will have to fill out this form before departing Guatemala. Printed copies are available at the Team House.
